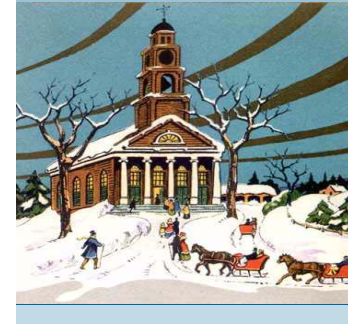

Pondering from Pastor Paul

Be Still and Know That I am God!

This weekend was a great adventure! I really enjoy the challenge of the winter storm. Mel doesn't understand that when everyone says, "Stay at home!" that I have to get out and go! It must be a guy thing, because Dave Haverly was already out and clearing the church walks before I could get out of the driveway! I claim that I have a responsibility to make sure the church is okay and that the walks and drive is clear for worship, but the reality is that I want to be in control!

It was an excellent time to practice what I preach! It was a built in day to reflect on the grace and mercy of God. It was a great time to spend some quality time with Mel. It was all of those things, but I was consumed with getting out of the drive and seeing what was going on in the rest of Goodlettsville!

Psalm 46:10 says, "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth. The LORD Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress."

I can really enjoy quiet and personal time with God, but I want to do it on my own terms! I want to be in control, even in my quiet time with God. As I reflect on the weekend, I have become aware that sometimes I cannot be in control. I cannot make the roads less slippery, nor can I control the snow-plows. Yet that unrest is a part of who I am and it is hard to stay home, be quiet, and enjoy the quietness of a snowy day.

You can only imagine the joy I felt as Dave called, said he had finished at the church and was on the way to Cima Drive to get me out! I felt like I had been delivered! I was so appreciative of him and his snow blower! What I could not do on my own, Dave was able to do for me. I had been released; I was free!

The Psalmist understood this when he wrote Psalm 46. While the world was literally crumbling around him, he was able to see clearly the redemption of God in the midst of the storm. This is what Jesus does in our lives when we stop our utter self-dependence and recognize that we cannot save ourselves. We need a redeemer!

Thanks you, David, for getting me out of Cima Drive. Thank you Jesus, for delivering me from my own sin and self consuming attitudes of life! Help me live in thankfulness, to take time to "be still and know that you are God!"

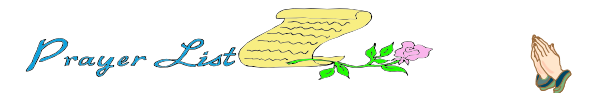
